These show-stopping shrubs are loved by birds for their delicious fruit, by insects and hummingbirds for their sweet winter nectar, and by humans for their fragrant leaves and rainy season flowers. Currants are found throughout the campus landscapes. In the Arboretum they are found hanging out in shade of their taller neighbors. The species featured in the photo, called the chaparral currant, Ribes malvaceum, loses its leaves but emerges in winter with eye-catching, chandelier-like flowers.
